General Materials:

2 sheets of Pastel Matt Paper, I used a grey color, but any color will do.

Soft Pastels:

I used Jack Richeson’s pastels, Linda Richichi Color and Energy Set of 80, but other types of soft pastels in similar colors will work! I listed what the colors look like, then in parentheses I added the color name and number for Richeson’s pastels if you want to get those.

Dark green (45)	Yellow Ochre (Orange 7)
Orange (Orange 5)	Dark orange (Earth Orange 30)
