### **Instructional Hint for Applying Snowtex:**

With clear tape or packing tape, tape a corner of a small plastic bag. Place Snowtex into the bag and squeeze Snowtex into taped corner. Cut off corner diagonally about 3/16<sup>th</sup> inch. Like icing, pipe Snowtex onto surface where desired. Use a palette knife to spread if needed. Allow to dry.
